Cursillo Keeps Growing

There has been a lot of activity in the Charlotte Diocese Cursillo this past year. The Cursillo Movement continues to assess its direction, all the while trying to follow the true charism of its founder, Eduardo Bonnin.

Step by Step is the original Weekend Rector's Guide developed by Eduardo Bonnin. A committee in our diocese has been formed to implement these guidelines.

School of Leaders (which is the working arm of the Movement) has taken a big leap forward by creating groups or teams that will gather in breakout sessions during the meetings to discuss their activities in (1) making Step by Step viable for a Weekend Retreat, (2) enhancing the meal experience via the Kitchen assignment, (3) creating a Cursillo presence at the Eucharistic Congress, (4) preparing for our next Grand Ultreya, and (5) working to Grow and Spread Cursillo in the Diocese.

Secretariat has just revised its *bylaws* to better reflect its activities. Changes in membership have recently taken place: some have dropped off while new ones have taken over those assignments.

At this time, we recognize our retiring Lay Director, Kathy Crisson, for her efforts working to serve the Movement. **John Sequeira** will be our new Lay Director.

Miralee Ackerson is leaving Women's 3-Day Chair for her new position as the Assistant Lay Director. **Olivia Schmidt** will be stepping in as the 3-Day Women's Chair.

Warren Grasheim will replace John Eiffe for the Men's 3-Day Chair.

Carol Ball is leaving Postcursillo and will be succeeded by **Hamp Dulin**. The Assistant Postcursillo position will need to be filled.

Beth Ann Dulin will be taking over for Tricia Bunch for School of Leaders. Adona Towner steps down from Assistant School of Leaders to be replaced by **Barbara Dean**.
